## **Service Requested:**

Printing and Promo material service for various projects of the SFPL in GEO office

### **1. The tasks under planned assignment are as follows:**

- 1.1. Print training and conference materials;
- 1.2. Produce various promo materials.

### **2. Duration of the assignment:**

Upon request during the year of 2024, until December 31st, including, with possible term of extension, subject to terms and conditions of the agreement to be signed between parties.

### **3. Place(s) of Assignment**

Tbilisi, Georgia

### **4. Minimum requirements**

4.1 Minimum 1 year of working experience in the field.

4.2 A dedicated focal point for SFPL speaking at least one of the following foreign languages (English and/or Russian, and/or Polish).

### **5. Selection criteria for shortlisted applicants (max. 100 points)**

## FINANCIAL (price) EVALUATION

The financial evaluation will be made based on the total cost of the financial evaluation (price of the offer), calculated on the basis of the cost simulation scenario provided in the Application form.

Assessment under the criterion „price” will be based on the following formula for each category:

$$P = P_{min}/P_{of} \times 40 \text{ points}$$

where:

$P_{min}$  - the lowest proposed price

$P_{of}$  – price presented in the examined offer

$P$  – the number of points awarded to the examined offer under the price criterion, rounded to the full number.

## AWARD OF THE CONTRACT

The contract will be awarded to the most economically advantageous tender, which will be established by weighing technical quality against price on a 60/40 basis.

The final score will be calculated using the following formula:

$$\text{Final score} = \text{Technical score} \times 60\% + \text{Financial score} \times 40\%$$

The tender obtaining the highest final score will be deemed to be the most economically advantageous tender.

\*Comparison of the weight of Price and other criteria is 40/60%

## 6. Information about price:

6.1. The price should be specified in GEL and rounded to two decimal places. The price should be given on the basis of the cost simulation scenario provided in the Application form.

6.2. The price may be offered in NET (for physical persons) value, that must be clearly indicated, or GROSS, that should include all costs incurred by the Contracting Authority as part of the service

provided by the Contractor (taxes, compulsory social security, health and retirement contributions), as well as the costs of accommodation in Georgia, food, insurance, local travel (unless travel is ordered separately by Contracting Authority), computer equipment, cellular communication and software (word processor / spreadsheet / power point) if any.

6.3. Settlements between the Contracting Authority and the Contractor will be conducted in GEL depending on the Contractor's place of tax residence and in relation to the current exchange rate of the National Bank of Georgia.

**7. The application must contain Fiscal Statement and Application FORMS (templates attached), signed and scanned in PDF format.**
