INTERNET ACCESS FLAGSHIP: Rural Empowerment through Digital Inclusion (REDI) is an EU funded project that Solidarity Fund PL in Georgia (SFPL in GEO) began implementing on December 1st, 2023, together with our partner - the e-Governance Academy from Estonia (eGA).

By virtue of its innovative approach, this action will reduce the existing digital division and include those traditionally left behind by improving access to affordable digital infrastructure and developing digital literacy skills in rural areas of the target regions of Imereti, Guria, Racha-Lechkhumi, Kvemo Svaneti and Kakheti.

Service requested:

Provide expert legal consultations and support for the project Rural Empowerment through Digital Inclusion (REDI). This includes provision of legal advice and analysis, preparation of contracts, agreements, delivery-acceptance acts and other legal documents in the English and Georgian languages.

1. Duration of the assignment:

Upon request, during the year 2025, with possible terms of extension.

2. Place(s) of Assignment

The selected tenderer will be providing service mostly remotely. Physical presence might be requested from time to time.

3. Minimum requirements

- 3.1 A law degree from an accredited law school.
- 3.2 A minimum of 3 years of legal experience in drafting legal documents, legal analysis, oral legal consultations.
- 3.3 Fluency in the English language.
- 3.4 Availability to perform requested tasks within decent deadlines to be suggested by the applicant.

Offers from service providers that do not meet the minimum criteria will be rejected for formal reasons.

4. Apart from minimum requirements, following criteria for selection will be assessed based on the points provided (max. 55 points)

4.1 More than 5 years of of legal experience in drafting legal documents, legal analysis, oral legal consultations - max. 15 points

5 to 10 years - 10 points

Over 10 years – 15 points

4.2 Legal experience in the telecommunications field – max. 10 points

1 to 3 years – 5 points

Over 3 years – 10 points

4.3 Responsiveness/Availability – max 10. Points

Available to respond to a task sent via email within 24 to 48 hours – 5 points

Available to respond to a task sent via email within 24 hours or less - 10 points

4.4 Cost of a single consultation (a single consultation equals 8 hours) - max. 20 points

Cost should be provided in the designated field in the application form.

Assessment under the criterion "cost" will be processed based on the following formula:

P= Pmin/Pof x 20 points

where:

Pmin - the lowest proposed price
Pof – price presented in the examined offer
P – the number of points awarded to the examined offer under the price criterion, rounded to the full number.

The workload in a number of hours needed to implement a special task will be agreed in a written form prior to the execution of the tasks. Settlements between the Contracting Authority and the Contractor will be conducted in EUR depending on the Contractor's place of tax residence and in relation to the current EUR exchange rate of the National Bank of Georgia.
