Solidarity Fund PL in Georgia is looking for a company to supply and deliver IT equipment and peripherals throughout the year

Service Requested:

Provision service of IT peripheral devices for various projects of the SFPL-GEO office.

1. The tasks under planned assignment are as follows:

- 1.1. Provide IT peripheral devices when requested;
- 1.2. Deliver them timely and to the venue free of charge;
- 1.3. Provide support services when required, including response times for troubleshooting and repairs;
- 1.4. Ensure devices meet specific industry standards and certifications;
- 1.5. Satisfy the requirements for energy efficiency and environmental compliance;
- 1.6. Include detailed documentation for each device, having user manuals and warranty information in product packagings;
- 1.7. Provide Quality Assurance certifications along with products.

2. Duration of the assignment:

Upon request during the year, including, with possible provisions of extension, subject to terms and conditions of the agreement to be signed between parties.

3. Place(s) of Assignment:

Tbilisi, Georgia

4. Minimal requirements:

- 4.1 Holding a minimum of 5-year-operating experience in the field of provision of IT peripheral devices;
- 4.2 Ensuring that pricing adheres to relevant regulations and staying competitive and valid throughout the contracting period;
- 4.3 Offering a selection of alternatives with different quality grades:
- 4.4 Guarantee period for all IT peripheral items should be a minimum of 12 months;
- 4.5 A dedicated focal point for SFPL speaking at least one of the following foreign languages (English and/or Russian).



5. Selection criteria for shortlisted applicants (max. 100 points)

 Price and quality of services: Competitive prices on items (max. 60 points); Free-of-charge delivery of the items to the requested venue (max. 10 points). 	70
 Offering a selection of alternatives with different quality grades: At least 3 options of the same product is offered - max. 5 points, less than 3 options - 3 points; The options comply with safety, performance, environmental, security, and interoperability standards and regulations (max. 5 points); Internationally recognized brands with a warranty period at least 12 months (max. 5 points), if the warranty is shorter or not available - 0 points. 	15
3. Time of delivery (If you are able to provide the order within 48 hrs. – 10 p., within 72 hrs. – 7 p., within a week – 3 p., 7 days or more – 0 p.) (max. 10 points)	10
4. Responsiveness (If you are able to respond to our email within 24 hrs 5 p., within 48 hrs 2.5 p., 72 hrs. or more - 0 p.) (max. 5 points).	5

FINANCIAL (price) EVALUATION

The financial evaluation will be made based on the total cost of the financial evaluation (price of the offer), calculated on the basis of the cost simulation scenario provided in the Application form.

Assessment under the criterion "price" will be based on the following formula for each category:

P= Pmin/Pof x 60 points

where:

Pmin - the lowest proposed price

Pof - price presented in the examined offer

P – the number of points awarded to the examined offer under the price criterion, rounded to the full number.

AWARD OF THE CONTRACT

The contract will be awarded to the most economically advantageous tender, which will be established by weighing technical quality against price on a 40/60 basis.

The final score will be calculated using the following formula:

Final score = Technical score x 40% + Financial score x 60%

The tender obtaining the highest final score will be deemed to be the most economically advantageous tender.

^{*}Comparison of the weight of Price and other criteria is 60/40%



6. Information about price:

- 6.1. The price should be specified in GEL and rounded to two decimal places. The price should be given on the basis of the cost simulation scenario provided in the Application form.
- 6.2. The price may be offered in NET (for physical persons) value, that must be clearly indicated, or GROSS, that should include all costs incurred by the Contracting Authority as part of the service provided by the Contractor (taxes, compulsory social security, health and retirement contributions), as well as the costs of accommodation in Georgia, food, insurance, local travel (unless travel is ordered separately by Contracting Authority), computer equipment, cellular communication and software (word processor / spreadsheet / power point) if any.
- 6.3. Settlements between the Contracting Authority and the Contractor will be conducted in GEL depending on the Contractor's place of tax residence and in relation to the current exchange rate of the National Bank of Georgia.
- 7. The application must contain Fiscal Statement FORM and Application FORM (templates attached), signed and scanned in PDF format.
